- The nature of papers can be theoretical, empirical, or methodological.

- Various formats will be considered: standard academic paper, concept paper, re-edited article, research note, working paper, report resume, etc.
- Confirm your intention to attend and/or present a paper (with a title), in-person or on-line, by email before **June 5, 2022**.
- Deadline: a draft paper with a minimum of 3000 words should be submitted before September 15, 2022.
- Please prepare a PPT presentation for around 20 minutes
